Scope

- Actively involving staff and subcontractors in hazard identification and risk mitigation through collaboration and consultation.
- Conducting site-specific inductions using tools such as Buildpass and Procore in accordance with the CIMA methodology (Consult, Inspect, Monitor, Audit).
- Setting measurable objectives and targets to eliminate workplace injuries, illnesses, and pollution while promoting client satisfaction.
- Continuously maintain and improve risk management processes to ensure effectiveness and relevance.
- Promptly addressing client concerns to resolve hazards and risks efficiently.

Implementation

- Providing training and resources to help all personnel understand their roles and responsibilities.
- Conducting regular audits, inspections, and reviews to uphold high standards.
- Promoting open communication during safety meetings and Toolbox Talks.
